PROPOSED CHANGE

The governing body of this club is the Board, consisting of the President, President Elect, President Nominee, Immediate Past President, Secretary/Treasurer, and 10 Directors.



This change is being made to repair grammatical errors, adjust terminology, and to increase the number of directors from 8 to 10.
