## 2018-2019 Operating Budget Include \$100,000+ for Community

The Board of Directors approved an operating budget for the 2018-2019 year of \$161,670.00. Highlights include over \$100,000 budgeted for Community Giving. Those include:

- Nearly \$35,000 for community projects
- \$35,000 for recipients of funding raised from Wine Walk
- Youth Programs: \$7000 for RYLA, \$8500 Youth Scholarships, \$1000 for Interact, \$2000 for Rotary Youth Exchange
- \$500 for Bus Jam Toy and Food Drive
- \$2000 for Shots for Tots
- \$5000 for Gift of Literacy
- \$8000 for International Service Projects
- \$1200 Coos Foundation
